

Our zero-work injury goal is inspired by our desire to deliver each employee home as safe and healthy as when they arrived.

Schupan adheres to a culture of safety and promotes the standard that "Nothing we do is worth doing unsafely" so all employees develop active safety behaviors. Instilling a "See something, say something" mentality has been an important initiative, adding to the values of a proactive safety culture and work environment.

Implementing standard operating procedures and controls, such as lock-out-tag-out, and providing sufficient resources to support supervisors at all levels improves the safety of everyone at our facilities.

All employees receive year-round training and guidance for safety-related issues and machine operation.

Every month, all levels of the Schupan team gather at each facility for a safety meeting. An open-door policy allows our staff to communicate effectively and work together to mitigate the risk of injuries and accidents.

All machines must be properly locked out and tagged out before maintenance work can commence.

Driving Change: The Impact of Michigan's Deposit Law

Michigan's 10-cent bottle deposit law has been key to recycling efforts since 1976, but redemption rates have declined—from over 90% to just 73% in 2023. This drop impacts both the environment and the economy, reducing the reuse of valuable materials and weakening the state's recycling infrastructure. Every unreturned container represents lost resources and missed opportunities to support Michigan's sustainability efforts.

As the nation's largest independent processor of used beverage containers, Schupan Recycling plays a vital role in keeping these materials in circulation. Higher redemption rates support sustainability, reduce landfill waste, and provide economic benefits to consumers and local businesses.

Recognizing the need for action, Schupan launched the "Take 'em Back" campaign in 2024 with support from a Michigan EGLE grant. This statewide initiative includes TV and radio ads, billboards, and a website promoting bottle returns. A key focus is a school program for 2nd and 3rd graders, fostering lifelong recycling habits.

Beyond environmental benefits, the campaign also strengthens Michigan's recycling infrastructure. Increased bottle and can returns ensure a steady supply of high-quality recyclable materials, reducing reliance on virgin resources and supporting jobs in processing facilities across the state. By boosting redemption rates, Schupan is helping to create a more resilient and sustainable circular economy. These efforts not only benefit the environment today but also lay the foundation for a stronger recycling system for future generations.

Early results are promising—redemption rates have already risen by 2%. But there's more to do. Every bottle and can counts. By returning your containers, you help protect Michigan's environment, support jobs, and promote a sustainable future.

Our Approach to the Circular Economy

At Schupan, we are deeply committed to sustainable practices and contributing to the circular economy. Our approach includes:

- Building products that last
- Distributing sustainable material solutions throughout the globe
- Connecting our partners with services to reuse, reduce, and recycle their materials

We collect, process, and sell ferrous and nonferrous metals for manufacturers and businesses. Our retail locations in Elkhart and Kalamazoo even buy metal from the public. The metal collected within our programs is taken to mills throughout the United States before, in some cases, being repurchased by Schupan for use in our manufacturing facilities.

Schupan Aluminum & Plastics prioritizes the use of recycled and sustainably sourced materials in our

manufacturing processes, minimizing our environmental footprint. By incorporating post-consumer and postindustrial recycled aluminum and plastics, we reduce the demand for virgin resources and lower energy consumption.

This effort is further strengthened by our close collaboration with our Industrial Recycling business unit, which provides a consistent stream of high-quality recycled materials. This internal loop ensures a reliable supply chain while significantly reducing waste going to landfills.

We actively promote closed-loop recycling systems, encouraging our customers to return end-of-life products for reprocessing. By doing so, we create a truly circular flow of materials, fostering a more sustainable future.

Circularity in Action

Our Elkhart, Indiana, location supports waste diversion for the trailer and RV industries in Northern Indiana. The scrap collected contributes to creating 1/4" forklift brake plates in our Dayton, Ohio, manufacturing facility.

Delivering Circularity in the **Global Supply Chain**

Schupan is the nation's largest privately-owned processor and marketer of used beverage containers. Our processing facilities receive, sort, process, and market billions of used beverage containers generated annually by Michigan and Iowa's deposit laws. We use innovative technology such as mechanized material separation, optical sorters, color sorting, crushing, shredding, and baling. We are widely recognized as America's most advanced beverage container recycling system.

Over 75 consumer-based industries rely on Schupan to optimize this commodities supply chain from process to producer to provide high-quality materials back to the market. Working in partnership with those consumer based industries, our supply chain is networked in over 20 countries and supported by offices in Mexico and throughout the United States.

Through innovation, Schupan's higher recyclability rate supports manufacturers' recycled content goals by processing and distributing high-quality aluminum, plastics, and fiber domestically and abroad.

Full-Product Destruction

We help the food and beverage industry by handling expired and damaged products. In 2022, our program achieved zero waste.

Residential Recycling

Our Des Moines, Iowa, materials recovery facility partners with cities to provide curbside recycling options, diverting over 20 million pounds of material from landfills annually.

We support manufacturers' recycled content goals by providing high-quality material through our custom recycling programs, technologies and supply chains. With facilities in Iowa and Michigan, we grow our local relationships while expanding our global footprint.



Providing Community Solutions

Since 2021, Schupan has held 61 electronics recycling drives throughout Michigan, collecting over 347,000 pounds of material.

As one of the few providers to perform such services and one of three in the State of Michigan that is RIOS/R2v3 certified, our partnerships with cities around Michigan provide valuable support in reaching our clients' waste reduction goals while safely protecting data.

Schupan specializes in providing unique solutions to our customers, clients, and communities, keeping waste from turning to litter, providing a clean source of recycled material for the manufacture of new products, and providing solutions to the public for the purchasing of materials.

Since 2015, we have been a preferred vendor for the State of Michigan in the collection of water bottles in communities with water quality issues. In the City of Flint and Benton Harbor, we have collected over 6.5 million water bottles, keeping the entire recycling and re-processing of those containers locally within Michigan.



In working with municipalities and other organizations, we're able to handle hard-to-recycle items such as electronics and recover valuable materials such as precious metals, which lessens the demand for mining raw materials like copper, gold, silver, and platinum.

Since 2008, Schupan has partnered with events and cities across Michigan and the Midwest to provide event and public space recycling solutions. Since its inception, we've partnered with 583 projects, diverting more than 4.5 million pounds of material from the landfill.

- Introduced the first outdoor event recycling program in the City of Flint, MI

By diverting aluminum from landfills and reducing reliance on primary aluminum production, the center significantly lowers the carbon footprint of aluminum manufacturing.

Comprehensive Aluminum Recycling

The facility collects a variety of aluminum scrap, including:

- Old Sheet Items such as house siding, pots and pans, old aluminum boats, and trailers.
- Old Extrusion Includes windows, doors, pool enclosures, and patio enclosures.

Once collected, these materials undergo a rigorous sorting, cleaning, and shredding process using advanced technology to maximize material recovery and minimize waste. The processed aluminum is categorized as:

- 3xxx/MLC Shred Used in flat-rolled products like beverage cans, building materials, and trailer siding.
- 6xxx Shred Cast into billets for extrusion into windows, doors, structural components, and medical

Sustainable Impact & High Output

With the capacity to process 2 million pounds of shredded aluminum per month per shift, the Jim Paternoster Processing Center is a major contributor to the growing demand for low-carbon aluminum. Recycling aluminum requires just 5% of the energy needed for primary aluminum production, significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions while conserving natural resources.
